As of this date, MassDOT oversees four new divisions: Highway, Rail and Transit, Aeronautics and Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV). All references throughout JOURNEY TO 2030 of future activities by the Executive Office of Transportation (EOT), the Massachusetts Highway Department (MassHighway), and the Massachusetts Tumpike Authority (MassPike) will now refer to the new agency – MassDOT. Specific references to the Massachusetts Highway Department (MassHighway) will now refer to the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT).
