AMENDMENT 4 TRANSIT AND TRANSIT CARRYOVER:

SECTION 5307 FUNDING:

Project Name: Locomotive and Coach Procurement

Project Description: Program calls for procurement of 28 locomotives and 75 bi-level coaches.

Current Authorized Project Budget: According to the MBTA adopted Capital Investment Program authorized budgets are: \$186 million for Locomotive Procurement; \$232 million for Commuter Rail Coaches.

TIP Amendment: Project funding for FFY09 previously totaled \$17 million and is increased to \$24 million (\$19.2 million federal; \$4.8 million local match).

Schedule/Update: Locomotive procurement to be advertised Fall 2009; Coach delivery to start 2011.

Project Name: Blue Line Vehicles

Project Description: Procurement of 94 Blue Line cars to replace existing fleet.

Current Authorized Project Budget: \$216.35 million

TIP Amendment: No FFY09 5307 funding for this project to be programmed. (Previously had allocated \$8 million in federal funds matched by \$2 million local)

Schedule/Update: All vehicles have been delivered and project has adequate funding on hand at this time from prior year TIP programming.

Project Name: Bus and Train Arrival LCD Signage

Project Description: Introduction of next vehicle arrival customer information systems on Bus and Green Line

Current Authorized Project Budget: \$6 million (future funding to be requested)

TIP Amendment: This program was previously funding at \$3 million and with this amendment is increased to \$6 million (\$4.8 million federal; \$1.2 million local MBTA).

Schedule/Update: Funding for engineering/design and trial phase.

SECTION 5307 FUNDING (CARRYOVER):

Project Name: Redundant Operation Control Center

Project Description: Project involves upgrade and renovation of the bus maintenance building for heavy maintenance of CNG buses. Separate contract work would also include installation of necessary sprinkler, fire & security systems.

Current Authorized Project Budget:

TIP Amendment: No federal funds are proposed for programming at this time. Project was previously funded at \$10,815,398 (\$8,652,318 federal; \$2,163,080 local MBTA)

Schedule/Update: Project is suspended at this time.

Project Name: Commuter Rail Equpment Upgrades

Project Description: Project elements include radio frequency upgrade; plan development for Positive Train Control implementation on the commuter rail system as federally mandated; placement of onboard cameras in locomotive cabs; and implementation of computer diagnostic system to monitor Locomotive engine performance.

Current Authorized Project Budget: \$4.5 million (future funding to be rquested)

TIP Amendment: This project is new addition to the TIP reprogramming of \$3,652,319 in federal funds previously programmed for Redundant Operation Control Center.

Schedule/Update: Equipment installation 2009-2010; PTC plan to be completed Spring 2010.

Project Name: Maintenance Facility Equipment

Project Description: Upgrade/replacement of obsolete maintenance equipment including wheel lathe, pipe bender, fork lifts etc.

Current Authorized Project Budget: \$3.6 million (additional funding to be requested)

TIP Amendment: This project is new addition to the TIP reprogramming of \$3,000,000 in federal funds previously programmed for Redundant Operation Control Center.

Schedule/Update: Equipment to be procured over next several months.

Project Name: Orange Line Vehicles/Engineering

Project Description: Replacement of Orange Line fleet

Current Authorized Project Budget: \$137 million

TIP Amendment: This project is new addition to the TIP reprogramming of \$2,000,000 in federal funds previously programmed for Redundant Operation Control Center.

Schedule/Update: This funding is for vehicle engineering phase. Schedule calls for vehicle delivery approx. 2015-2018.
