Following is a list of issues for discussion raised by members of RTAC in consideration of updating the MPO Memorandum of Understanding.

1. Election Procedure: Reconstitute committee to revise election procedures. Major issue is limitation on city vs. town and regions. Simplify and open it up.

2. Organization of the MPO:

- a. Should there be more municipalities on the MPO? Should municipalities have a majority on the MPO?
- b. State currently has too many votes due to Reform that eliminated Turnpike Authority but didn't remove them from MPO.
- c. Should additional members be added to MPO to replace Turnpike Authority, such as:
 - i. Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs, to help promote GreenDOT initiative
 - ii. Executive Office of Housing and Economic Development, to promote consideration of land use and economic development in transportation planning
 - iii. Regional Transit Authority, to represent suburban transit needs
 - iv. Regional Economic Development organization
- d. Voting rules--Should the complicated voting system be replaced by a simple majority vote?
- e. Should chair be elected from MPO members?
- f. Should all committees be chaired by state agencies or by other members?
- g. RTAC should have a vote on MPO
- **3.** Prioritization Criteria—committee should be reconstituted, existing criteria reviewed and revised as needed
- 4. Central Artery section—is this still relevant? Revise or remove.
- 5. Role of MARPA in allocation of federal funds to MPO's.
