## **DIRECTIONS TO THE NORWOOD POLICE STATION**

### **BY CAR**

- o FROM THE NORTH AND EAST: Take I-95/Route 128 to Exit 15B (Route 1 South towards Norwood). Continue south on Route 1 for approximately 2.9 miles towards the Nahatan Street rotary. Take the exit towards Norwood Center to reach the rotary, then take the first right out of the rotary (this will be Nahatan St.). Continue westerly to 137 Nahatan St. Location will be on right side of the road.
- **o FROM THE SOUTH:** Take Route 1 North (Boston Providence Highway) towards the Neponset Street/Nahatan Street rotary. Take the exit towards Norwood Center to reach the rotary, then take the third right out of the rotary (this will be Nahatan St.). Continue westerly to 137 Nahatan St. Location will be on right side of the road.
- o FROM THE WEST: Take Route 109 East towards Westwood. In Westwood, take the first right after the intersection with Pond St. to get onto Nahatan St. Follow Nahatan St. south. Location will be on the left.

#### BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

- O Route 34E Bus (Walpole Center or Dedham Line—Forest Hills Sta. via Washington St.): Take the bus to the stop at Washington Street and Cottage Street in Norwood. Walk approximately one block east on Cottage Street. Turn left on Broadway. Walk a short distance north on Broadway to the intersection with Nahatan St. and turn right. Walk approximately two blocks southeast on Nahatan St. The Norwood Police Department will be on the left. (Approx. 0.1 miles—a 5-8 minute walk.)
- o Commuter Rail, Franklin Line: Take the train to the Norwood Depot stop. Walk southeast on Railroad Ave. towards Lenox St. Take the first right onto Lenox St., and then left onto Nahatan St. The Norwood Police Department will be on the left. (Approx. 0.3 miles—a 6 minute walk.)
